

2005 MacRostie Pinot Noir Wildcat Mountain Vineyard

Give this wine some time to open. It starts onedimensional, but as it opens it offers more Pommard than Russian River, deeply bruised plum and black cherries, earthy mushrooms still dirty with rich loam, all balanced by a hint of allspice and anise. This is a marvelous food wine, just begging for a braised veal shank.
