

2008 White Rose Estate Dundee Hills Pinot Noir

WHO: White Rose Wines

WHAT: Pinot Noir

WHERE: Willamette Valley, Oregon

WHEN: 2008

This showed darker fruits typical of 2008 Willamette Valley, getting more tart and adding citrus peel and spice on the midpalate, Spanish orange and cloves. Minerality and some smoky meat flavors came through on the finish. This will be very nice after some time, perhaps three or four years in the cellar. Food choices can go in two different directions, double up the spice with marinated flank steak, or create a spice-to-fat counterpoint by pairing it with a nice ribeye. Highly recommended. DH
