This is an exemplary Cabernet Franc, with beautiful fruit, remarkably fine texture, nice herbal edges, mineral undertones and subtle yet very present tension. This is a wine you could meditate over, if you so wish, or drink joyously with friends over a simple meal, now or 15-20 years down the line. Its only flaw is its rarity: the red makes very infrequent appearances in North America. It's worth keeping an eye out for. Highly recommended. RC

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
