

**2007 Pierre Gaillard Faugères  
“Transhumance”**

WHAT: 65% syrah, blended with carignan  
and grenache

WHERE: Languedoc, France

WHEN: 2007

Cows and sheep trekking down from the mountains have nothing to do with the “Transhumance” name of the wine; instead it’s the winemaker himself who makes the journey from the Northern Rhone down to the Languedoc region in the south of France. There, he has produced an earthy, smoky, syrah-based wine. A bit of the wild landscape there shows in a splash of minty herbs that appear toward the tail end of the aromas and drift into the flavors, to accompany the smoldering deep red berries that persist into the finish.
