

2010 Eden Road "The Long Road" Shiraz

WHO: Eden Road WHAT: Shiraz

WHERE: Hilltops. New South Wales.

Australia WHEN: 2010

The nose hints of Rhone, rather than Oz, with aromas of grilled meat and olives complementing blackberries dusted with graphite. On the palate, blackberries, the smoky charred end of prime rib, olives, pepper, and the tiniest hint of vanilla. Tannins are fine but full, acids match. This is a dark, rich, food-friendly wine, a doppelganger for a Northern Rhone. Drink with braised short ribs. Highly Recommended. DH.

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
