



2007 Trione Winery "Block 21" Cabernet Sauvignon

WHO: Trione Winery
WHAT: Cabernet Sauvignon (85%) plus Petite Verdot and Malbec
DESIGNATION: Block 21
WHERE: California, Alexander Valley
WHEN: 2007

The nose shows black currant and cedar. On the palate, sweet black currant and black cherry pair up front. Vanilla and cedar from wood treatment is obvious, but not overwhelming. A hint of pepper lingers with black cherry on a long finish. This is very ripe, with big soft tannins, a fat wine with the acids taking up the rear. With a hearty decant this can be enjoyed right away. Drink with rack of lamb. Recommended (88-90). DH
