Johannisberg Riesling Dry**

The color is very pale but the light catches flashes of bright gold. The nose is very soft and aromatic, starting with pears and honeysuckle, their sweetness tempered by a tiny grating of fresh lemon zest. The palate opens with fresh-cut tangy-sweet pineapple, merging into softer, sweeter, pears and honey. It ends with nutmeg and a quick flash of Riesling-true petrol, and a mid-length finish. This is a lovely bottle of wine. It has just enough sweetness to line up perfectly against spicy food, and is sunny and smooth enough to sip outside on a sunny afternoon.
