



2008 Anne Amie Pinot Blanc

WHO: Anne Amie Vineyards

WHAT: Pinot blanc

WHERE: Willamette Valley, Oregon

WHEN: 2008

The color is a pale yellow straw, clear and brilliant. Aromas of Asian pear, nectarine, and light citrus on the nose. In the mouth, a pleasant mix of pear, pineapple, and citrus, none of which are overwhelming, but well balanced. Lees aging gives the wine a wonderful mouthfeel and a slight creamy texture that combines well with the natural acidity for a pleasant, lingering finish. This combination will pair well with many foods, although it's very enjoyable on its own as well. WA
