## **2009 Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc Reserva – Chile**

WHO: Veramonte

WHAT: Sauvignon blanc

WHERE: Casablanca Valley, Chile

WHEN: 2009

Citrus, pineapple, and gooseberry, with a grassy background; reminiscent of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc before the Kiwis started filtering everything through the litter box. Flavors are clean, citrus bright, but slightly fat, not quite in balance. The gooseberry comes out stronger, tilting into "where's that darned cat?" as the wine warms up, so serve it while it is still chilled. Finish is mid-length. Drink with any fresh white fish, or just with a very hot day. DH

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
