The nose is sweetly aromatic, strawberries in cream, with lingering hints of vanilla. On the palate, it is still very young, very tight, but shows promise. Tannins are tight, but sweet. The finish keeps the red fruit trend going, leaving a strong, lingering, cherry stone flavor. Give it five years before opening again. Highly recommended. DH
