The nose shows blackcurrant and menthol. On the palate, this shows more red berries, particularly on the mid-palate. It opens with boysenberry and black cherry, then moves to tart red fruit, raspberry and tart hints of cranberry on the mid-palate. Vanilla shows on the mid-palate. Tannins are dusty, acids bright. The high-toned red berries on the mid-palate offer great diversity to this wine, allowing it to pair with a broad range of foods. Pair with wildfowl. Highly Recommended (92-94). DH

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
